INTERVIEWS CONDUCTED BY CLAUDE LEDOUX AND OTHERS.

INTRODUCTION: ‘ WESTPORT MATTERS’ cable TV shows were aired weekly on cable public access channel 17 from early 1993 to mid 2004. First showings on Fridays at 8:PM were repeated three times during the following few days. The shows were live from the cable studio as well as previously taped at various locations. There has been about 450 different shows, the following lists roughly 300 which have been archived. The archived material (computer discs) is available for historical information, or research, at the Westport Historical Society and Public Library. All Discs are DVD Format. Anyone interested in obtaining copies can contact Claude Ledoux if such are not available from the two above listed agencies.

Although the quality of some sessions is not of a professional nature, they are included due to their historical value to future researchers.

It is hoped my investment of a few thousand dollars, as well as volunteering about 4000 hours for; preparation, production and conversion to discs, will be of benefit to present and future researchers. My sincere thanks to the Westport Arts Council for their generous donation of \$1200.00 to help with completion of this project.

Sessions are listed chronologically and are also cross-referenced by subject. Listings are available on an Index CD (Microsoft WORD) which facilitates the search process.
